ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Have completed high school, with a minimum scholastic average of 75% (please submit most recent grades)
- Be currently enrolled in a pre-approved post-secondary institution
- Write a 500-word essay about the value of education and how education will brighten his/her future

There is no age restriction

WINNER OBLIGATIONS

1. Each scholarship winner is responsible for making arrangements with and meeting the academic requirements for entrance into a post-secondary institution of his/her choice.
2. Each scholarship winner is responsible for ensuring the institution meets the eligibility criteria of the scholarship program.
3. Following notification of his/her selection for scholarship, each scholarship winner must provide us with confirmation of admission to the post-secondary institution of his/her choice in order to receive the award.
